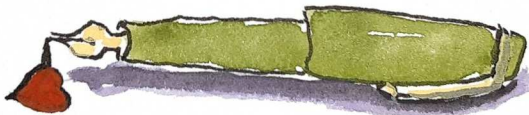

*Gilda greets most days with joy*

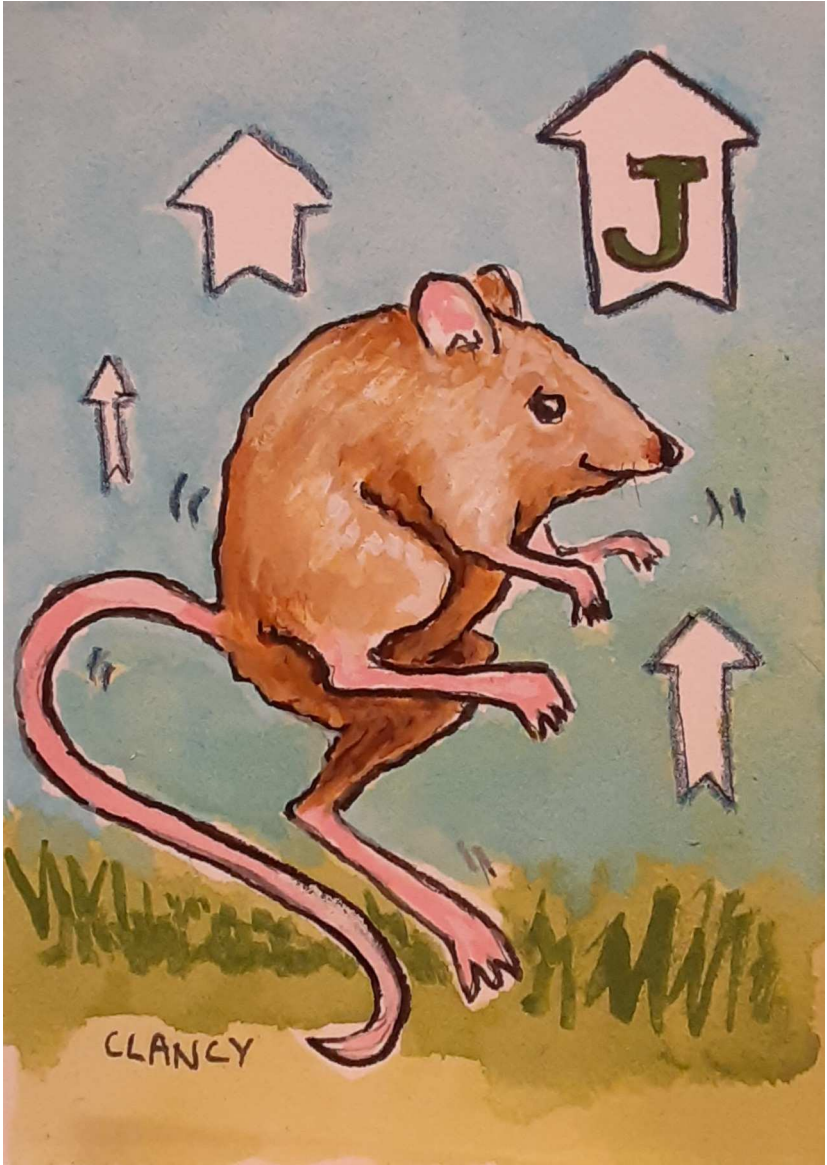


*Hammy has one favorite toy*

Ugo upsets the cart at a run



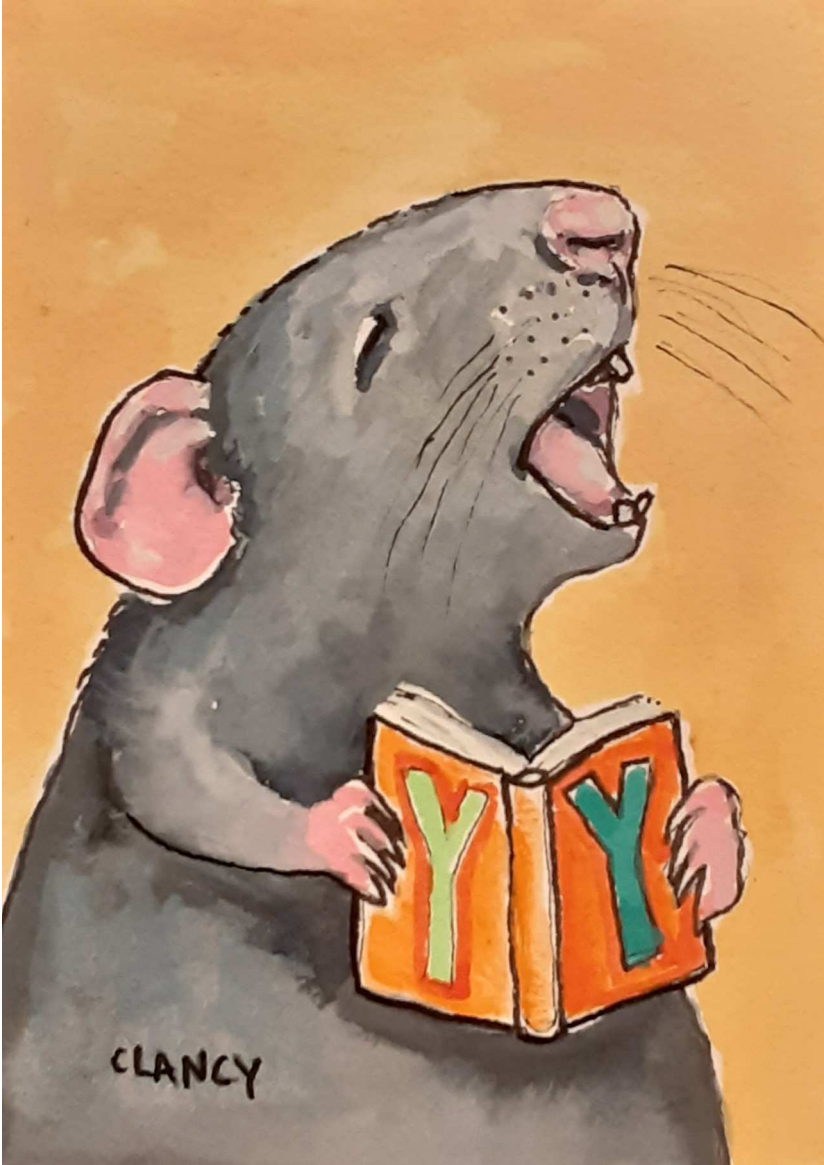
Vava vigorously twisted and spun

By the way the art in this book is bigger than the original artwork. Each original art piece is only 3.5 x 2.5 inches.

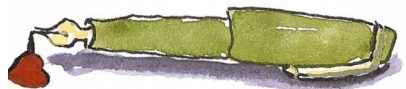
